Charleston Harbor Fest will be held on June 26, 27, and 28, 2009. The parade of sail of the tall ships leaving the harbor will be on Monday, June 29th.

Parking

Family Boat Building participants will receive one parking pass in an area designated by the Harbor Fest committee. All cars must remain out of the festival grounds until festival is closed to the public. There will also be extra parking in remote lots and in city garages.

Eligibility, Area Control, and participation

NO prior boat building experience is necessary. There will be helpful, qualified boat builders to assist you throughout the process.

This event is limited to 10 families/groups.

Start time for Family Boat Building will be at 9am on SATURDAY, June 27th. Boat Building will last approximately the whole day on Saturday and half of a day on Sunday.

Boat building will occur under the coverage of a large tent; therefore, the activity will take place whether we have rain or hot sun. Please come prepared for the weather.

Most of the boat's pieces will be precut. The boats will use high-quality mahogany marine plywood and Spanish cedar for framing. After the festival, the rowboat is yours to take home for years of enjoyment! Some tools are required to complete this design. You will need to bring:

Pair or two saw horses, cordless drill/driver with spare battery and charger, sharp hand-saw, six 3" or larger C-Clamps, canvas nail aprons, tape measure, square, bevel square (bevel gauge), 2 putty knives, 3/8" countersink for #8 flat head screw, small to medium size sharpened hand plane, caulking gun (will furnish caulk), life preservers for launch day, chairs, coolers for your refreshments (there will also be food vendors on site.)**If you do not have access to some of these items, please inform us and we will do our best to assist you.

There will be a Wooden Boat Exhibitor Awards Ceremony and Family Boatbuilding dinner. More information will be sent out once you are registered. On Sunday afternoon at 2:30pm there will be a parade of boats from the construction tent to the Maritime Center basin for the families to launch their finished boats.



Security

The South Carolina Maritime Foundation and Charleston Harbor Fest will provide security 24 hours a day from Thursday, June 25th until Sunday, June 28th, 2009. However, please safeguard all items and do not leave any valuables unattended. The SCMF and Charleston Harbor Fest are not responsible for any damaged, lost, or stolen items or goods. The SCMF will take all precautions as deemed necessary but all participants place their goods, exhibits, and personal items at the festival at their own risk.

All participants agree to “hold harmless” the South Carolina Maritime Foundation, Charleston Harbor Fest, all festival and foundation partners, volunteers and facilities for any damage, injury or losses to any person or property for any causes directly or indirectly related to participation in the Charleston Harbor Fest. If the festival facilities or grounds and/or its contents shall be destroyed or damaged by fire or any other cause, or if by reason of Government restriction or otherwise, the exhibition is interrupted or prevented, the exhibitor waives any claims for damages or compensation, consequential or otherwise including fee refunds, which might arise by reason of prevention or interruption.
