Charleston Harbor Fest will be held on June 26, 27, and 28, 2009. There will be a parade of sail out of the harbor for the tall ships on Monday, June 29th.

Festival Hours -Open to Public

Friday 10am-6pm
Saturday 10am-8pm
Sunday 10am-6pm

(Note: it is required that all exhibitors, artists, and static boats stay up, open, and supervised for the public during operating hours and until the close of the festival on Sunday evening.)

Registration

The Registration deadline is June 8, 2009. Full payment is due upon registration and no refunds will be given after application acceptance.

Payment

We accept checks, money orders, MC, Visa, AmEX, or Discover Cards. Please make all checks payable to Charleston Harbor Fest. All payment must be received with application. No refunds will be given after application acceptance.

Set-Up Dates and Times

Exhibitors may pick up their packets and set-up from 9am to 5pm on Thursday June 25, 2009. Booths must be set up by 5pm.

Tear Down Time

Booths and static displays must remain set up until the close of the festival on Sunday, June 28th, 2009. Tear down will begin after the festival closes on Sunday and must be finished by Monday at noon. No exceptions.

Parking

All exhibitors, artists, and display participants will receive one parking pass in an area designated by the Harbor Fest committee. All cars must remain out of the festival



grounds until festival is closed to the public. There will also be extra parking in remote lots and in city garages.

Eligibility and Area Control

Charleston Harbor Fest reserves the right to place each wooden boat in what they feel is the best area according to theme and to make things flow smoothly. Charleston Harbor Fest Committee also reserves the right to make the final decision as to which category an applicant may fall into.

No t-shirts or caps may be sold in booths unless hand-painted, hand-decorated or specifically approved by the Charleston Harbor Fest Committee.

No beverages or snacks will be allowed to be distributed or sold without prior permission by the Charleston Harbor Fest Committee prior to the festival.

Exhibitors, artists, and static displays must be open and ready for business thirty minutes prior to the opening of the festival daily and must not close down until after close daily of the festival.

Exhibitors, artists, and static displays that include the operation of audio/visual or lighting equipment must arrange so that the noise from said equipment will not annoy or disturb any contiguous or adjacent exhibitors. All audio/visual must be approved by the Charleston Harbor Fest Committee prior to the festival.

All copyrighted names and service marks may not be used or reproduced in any manner on merchandise, souvenir items or apparel by any exhibitor or artist. Exclusive rights on the words or phrases pertaining to the festival are the sole property of the South Carolina Maritime Foundation and their affiliates: The South Carolina Maritime Foundation, Charleston Harbor Fest, The Tall Ships are Coming!, Tall Ships Atlantic Challenge, Sail Training International, American Sail Training Association, and any of these logos.

Security

The South Carolina Maritime Foundation and Charleston Harbor Fest will provide security 24 hours a day from Thursday, June 25th until Sunday, June 28th, 2009. However, please safeguard all items and do not leave any valuables unattended. The SCMF and Charleston Harbor Fest are not responsible for any damaged, lost, or stolen items or goods. The SCMF will take all precautions as deemed necessary but all participants place their goods, exhibits, and personal items at the festival at their own risk.

All participants agree to "hold harmless" the South Carolina Maritime Foundation, Charleston Harbor Fest, all festival and foundation partners, volunteers and facilities for



any damage, injury or losses to any person or property for any causes directly or indirectly related to participation in the Charleston Harbor Fest. If the festival facilities or grounds and/or its contents shall be destroyed or damaged by fire or any other cause, or if by reason of Government restriction or otherwise, the exhibition is interrupted or prevented, the exhibitor waives any claims for damages or compensation, consequential or otherwise including fee refunds, which might arise by reason of prevention or interruption.

Miscellaneous

The South Carolina Maritime Foundation and the Charleston Harbor Fest reserve the right to make changes to these rules. Any matters not specifically covered are subject to decision by SCMF. SCMF reserves the right to make changes, amendments and additions to these rules as considered advisable for the proper conduct of the exhibit, with the provision that all exhibitors will be advised of any such changes.
