Charleston Harbor Fest 2008 invites you to join us for this year's event, scheduled for May 16-18. We anticipate 40,000+ visitors with attractions such as wooden boat exhibits, tours of tall ships including the Schooner Virginia, the Spirit of South Carolina and the Corwith Cramer, an authentic pirate camp, a children's village, family boat building, and education village, food, music and more! Access to the festival grounds is FREE.

Charleston Harbor Fest is an event of the SC Maritime Foundation. Proceeds from this event support educational programs for South Carolina youth aboard the Spirit of South Carolina tall ship.

We are looking forward to a successful event and celebrating our maritime heritage together!

**Rules & Information for Artists and Craftsmen:**

1. Charleston Harbor Fest will be held on May 16, 17, & 18<sup>th</sup>, 2008 from 10am to 5pm daily. Booths must remain open, supervised and intact for entire length of the Festival (Friday May 16- Sunday May 18).
2. Arts and crafts exhibits will be on display in individual booth spaces on the maritime center lawn. **The Artist fee in this area is \$125, due with this application. Artists will need to furnish their own tent, signage, tables, chairs, etc. Registration deadline is May 2, 2008.** You will be notified of acceptance no later than May 9th. If your application is not accepted, your artist fee will be returned.
3. Arts and Crafts displays outside must have a nautical theme (i.e. ships in bottles, artwork focusing on boats, the ocean, etc.). Only one exhibitor will be allowed per booth space.
4. Access to booth setup will begin at 9am on Thursday, May 15. All booths are expected to be setup by 5pm on Thursday. Artists must assume full responsibility for displays.
5. Charleston Harbor Fest and the SCMF are not responsible for damaged or stolen items during the day or night. We will have a security guard patrolling the grounds at night; however, this does not guarantee the safety of your artwork and other merchandise. Any valuable items should be removed when not being overseen. Leave items in your booth at your own risk.
6. The committee reserves the right to reject any application at their discretion.
